4. Teamwork	
Is there evidence that all pupils have been involved?	/5

5. Innovation	
Have pupils shown imagination and innovation in their response to the challenge?	/5
Is there something unique in the pupils' work?	/5
6. Argument	
Do pupils produce evidence to support their conclusions?	/5

7. Display	
Is the display clear and informative?	/5
