About the programme

Using Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP) industry growth areas, we work with local employers to develop enterprise challenges based on genuine issues that businesses face. This challenge changes on a termly basis so your students can participate in up to three challenges per year. The day is focused on students being tasked to find innovative solutions to the given challenge whilst developing key industry sector skills and knowledge.

This programme can also be tailored to specific themes, including STEM subjects or towards specific Key Stages and areas of interest.

Background

The EBP will facilitate a relationship between your school and a local business to work on a real-life business challenge before students have the opportunity to compete in an inter-school competition where they present their challenge solutions to a panel of business members with the winning team receiving recognition and a prize.

- Problem solving and application of design skills.
