About the programme

Working in partnership with our established network of employers and stakeholders across a range of different industries and sectors, our package includes a GDPR-compliant database with administrative assistance, a pre-placement workshop day, health and safety support to ensure all placements meet current guidelines, a placement support teaching resource pack and a post-placement workshop ideal for young people aged 14-25. All of our employers are provided with a full programme that they can tailor to their needs in advance of a young person starting with them.

Background

Work experience provides young people with practical, hands-on experiences of employment. The programme is invaluable in helping young people gain a real insight into what the world of work is like and can significantly contribute to their career-readiness.

1 Day Workshop – Pre-Placement

(Group size: 40)

A series of workshops delivered by The EBP including labour market information, routes into employment and a key note speaker from industry.

Placement Support Teaching Resource Pack – Issued to the school 2 weeks prior to placements taking place (delivered by schools’ teaching staff)

A comprehensive resource pack, created by The EBP, covering topics including placement attitudes, presentation and conduct, recording experiences and work/social life balance. The resource pack is designed to equip students with positive attitudes before, during and post placement and ensure personal and academic experiences are recorded appropriately whilst on placement.

Work Experience Placements

A unique experience to help students gain first-hand experience of a workplace, working with both employers and employees.

1 Day ‘Insight’ Workshop – Post-Placement (Group size: 40)

A full day workshop, delivered by The EBP to support students to reflect on their experience on placement and to use their knowledge to help form choices on their future careers.

Workshop aims:

- To reflect on the placement and the experiences encountered.
- To make informed decisions about future career choices and next steps.
- To be able to apply newly developed skills and knowledge into a communication-focussed series of activities.
