This programme can feature a visit to a local airfield to learn about forces acting on parachutes and how they are used in real life. Sky's the Limit can also include a visit to a news and weather studio to find out about weather forecasting and how reports are created and presented. Finally, there is an optional visit from a meteorological society to share how weather is forecast and presented.
