### About the programme

Support 4 Stars is one of our 'Wonder of the World' or 'WOW' programmes, designed to give KS1 and KS2 children a taste of the world of work and careers. This exciting programme can include a group visit to an animation studio to give children an insight into how animation is created. This can be followed by a trip to a local cinema to see animation come to life in a film. Whilst there, the group will learn about the operation of a cinema.

Each of our 'WOW' programmes can be tailored to individual schools and cohorts. Our programmes are focussed on children being supported and challenged through inspiring activities and working towards innovative solutions whilst developing their teamwork, self-confidence and problem solving and also developing key industry sector skills and knowledge.
