About the programme

This 'WOW' programme can feature a visit to a local coffee shop or tea room to investigate how they are managed and run. The programme can also include a school visit from a pottery business. During this session, pupils can be given the opportunity to design and make a tea cup or mug to take home. As part of this themed programme, there is also the opportunity for pupils to visit a historic country house to research banquets. This business focussed programme gives pupils the opportunity to gain an insight into the world of work and possible careers.

Each of our 'WOW' programmes can be tailored to individual schools and cohorts. Our programmes are focussed on children being supported and challenged through inspiring activities and working towards innovative solutions whilst developing their teamwork, self-confidence and problem solving whilst developing key industry sector skills and knowledge.
